- The Perinatal Summit is in its second phase. At this point the health care leaders are developing an Action Plan that will be implemented within eighteen months. More information about the summit is available on our website: www.labestbabies.org.
- The forums are up and running now. These forums will serve as an electronic venue for enhancing communication, collaboration, info-sharing, and technical assistance among collaborative members to discuss issues related to pregnancy and birth.
- An announcement was made that the Los Angeles Best Babies Collaborative changed its name and logo. We have chosen **LA Best Babies Network**. The new name describes the nature of the work we are doing, it is short and succinct, easy to communicate and remember, inclusive and inviting, and It reflects our past and future work.
- **Sex sub-committee report**
Ms. Nicole Anderson reported that The Grace Elliot Center is one of the agencies providing sex education within SPA 6, they also provide the following services: Pregnancy Testing, Baby Supplies, Parenting workshops, and Abstinence Education.
